## **Nuclear Medicine Stress Test**

## **Patient Instructions**

You have been scheduled for a Nuclear Medicine Stress Test at \_\_\_\_\_ AM /PM on \_\_\_/\_\_\_/

- <u>DO NOT</u> eat or drink anything for <u>6 hours</u> prior to your appointment. Insulin dependent diabetics may eat one slice of toast for breakfast if blood sugar is less than 100.
- <u>DO NOT</u> drink any caffeinated beverages (coffee, tea, cocoa, soft drinks) or eat any chocolate for at least 24 hours before the study. <u>NO DECAF COFFEE</u> <u>or TEA</u>
- Medication Instructions:
  - If taking the long acting insulin Lantus, take only half (1/2) of your usual evening and morning dose the night before your procedure and <u>DO NOT</u> taking your usual morning dose the day of the procedure.
  - **HOLD** the following medications:
    - Beta Blockers (Nebivolol, Carvedilol, Atenolol, etc. ALL the " lol drugs") Also, Calcium Channel Blockers (Cardizem)
  - **TAKE** the following medications with a sip of water:
    - All other Blood Pressure Medications (Lisinopril)
- Please bring all of your medications with you in labeled containers, including inhalers.
- Wear comfortable clothes and shoes as you may need to walk on a treadmill during one portion of this test.
- Check-in at The Imaging Center at FMH at the appointed time above.
- You will have an IV for this test.
- This test will take approximately 4 to 5 hours to complete. You will have some free time between the first and second portions of the test.
